4. Selected applicants will be required to provide the North Asia CAPE with their final survey (guidelines will be provided).
5. Selected applicants must be available for participation for approximately 5 hours a week throughout the duration of the programme from 23 August, 2021 – 03 September, 2021. There will also be an orientation prior to the tour starting.
6. The award is tenable only by a student who is a citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand.
7. The North Asia CAPE will award places based on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
