Terms and conditions

Conditions of Application:

- 1. The information requested in the application form will be used for assessment purposes. All personal information collected during the application process may be made available to members of the selection committee.
- 2. North Asia CAPE will normally hold documents about selected applicants for the duration of the award.
- 3. Consistent with the provisions of the Privacy Act applicants have the right of access to information held about them. Applicants also have the right to request the correction of information held about them.
- 4. North Asia CAPE wishes to recognise selected applicants and to keep informed about the progress of the students they have supported. In accepting this opportunity, you authorise North Asia CAPE to release information about your award and your experience. In addition, you authorise North Asia CAPE to request information on your academic status following the study tour.
- 5. Participation in the China Business Hybrid Study Tour is completely voluntary and North Asia CAPE and its Programme Partners should not be held liable for any damages, losses or related claims as a result of unforeseeable or unavoidable acts and risks, including those arising from travel.
- 6. Photographs, film and/or audio may be used by North Asia CAPE for marketing purposes of any kind at any time in the future. Images may be cropped, altered, transformed or reproduced in any way and may be combined with other works or text.

Regulations:

- 1. Selected applicants will be known as North Asia Centre of Asia-Pacific Excellence (CAPE) Scholars.
- 2. Selected applicants will be provided with the following at no cost for their full participation in the programme.

a. All in-person events, including transport to and from any such events; students may be required to pay for their own transport between their home and the airport in their city of residence.

b. Course materials

Anything outside of this package shall be borne by the participants.

- 3. Selected applicants must attend and present at a ceremony debriefing their Study Tour, if requested, and make their best efforts to be available for any promotional publicity related to the Study Tour.
- 4. Selected applicants will be required to provide North Asia CAPE with their final survey (guidelines will be provided).
- 5. Selected applicants must be available for participation for approximately 5 hours a week throughout the duration of the programme from 17-27 April, 2023. There will also be an orientation on 15 April prior to the tour starting.
- 6. The award is tenable only by a student who is a citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand.
- 7. North Asia CAPE will award places based on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
- 8. Application closing date: 10 March, 2023 unless otherwise stated.
- 9. North Asia CAPE has power to amend or vary these Terms and Conditions.
