TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Conditions of application

- 1) The information requested in the application form will be used for assessment purposes. All personal information collected during the application process may be made available to members of the selection committee to choose the successful applicants (Selected Applicants).
- 2) North Asia CAPE will normally hold documents about Selected Applicants for the duration of the award.
- 3) Consistent with the provisions of the Privacy Act, applicants have the right of access to information held about them. Applicants also have the right to request the correction of information held about them.
- 4) North Asia CAPE wishes to recognise Selected Applicants and to keep informed about the progress of the students it has supported. In accepting this opportunity, you authorise North Asia CAPE to release information about your award and your experience. In addition, you authorise North Asia CAPE to request information on your academic status following the study tour.
- 5) Photographs, film and/or audio may be used by North Asia CAPE for marketing purposes of any kind at any time in the future. Images may be cropped, altered, transformed or reproduced in any way and may be combined with other works or text.
- 6) Participation in the Korea Japan Tourism Study Tour 2023 programme is voluntary and North Asia CAPE and its Programme Partners will not be held liable for any damages, losses, or related claims as a result of an unforeseeable or unavoidable acts and risks.

Regulations

- 1) North Asia CAPE will award places based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee.
- 2) The award is tenable only by students who are citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand.
- 3) The application closing date is 17 August, 2023 unless otherwise stated.
- 4) Selected Applicants will be known as North Asia Centre of Asia-Pacific Excellence Scholars (CAPE Scholars).
- 5) Selected Applicants will be provided with the following at no cost for their full participation in the programme:
 - a. International Travel to Korea and Japan
 - b. Domestic transfers to Auckland
 - c. Accommodation in Korea and Japan
 - d. Activities scheduled as part of the Study Tour

e. Two tourism workshops, one run by Tony Boot BTM, and the other by the University of Otago Anything outside of this package shall be borne by the participants, including meals and incidentals in Korea and Japan.

- 6) Selected Applicants must attend all activities on this study tour and notify North Asia CAPE in advance if they are unable to attend.
- 7) Selected Applicants must attend all locations scheduled that are part of the study tour, to participate fully at each location (requirements will be provided), and to co-operate with any promotional publicity related to the digital study tour.
- 8) Selected Applicants will be required to organise their own Business Visa's to Japan and South Korea, supported by the North Asia CAPE.

- 9) Selected Applicants will be required to secure a negative RAT test before flying to Auckland and participating in the tour.
- 10) Selected Applicants will be required to provide North Asia CAPE with either a final report, presentation, or video on their learnings and reflections from the study tour (guidelines will be provided).
